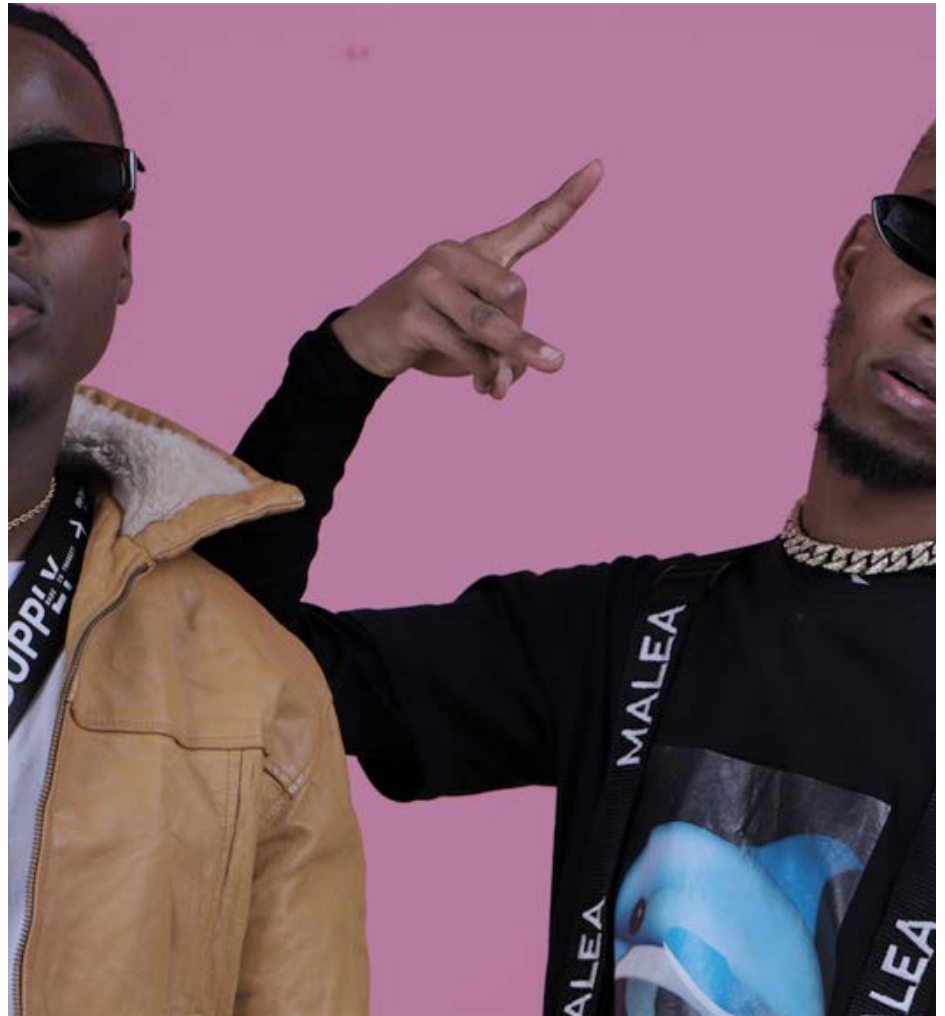

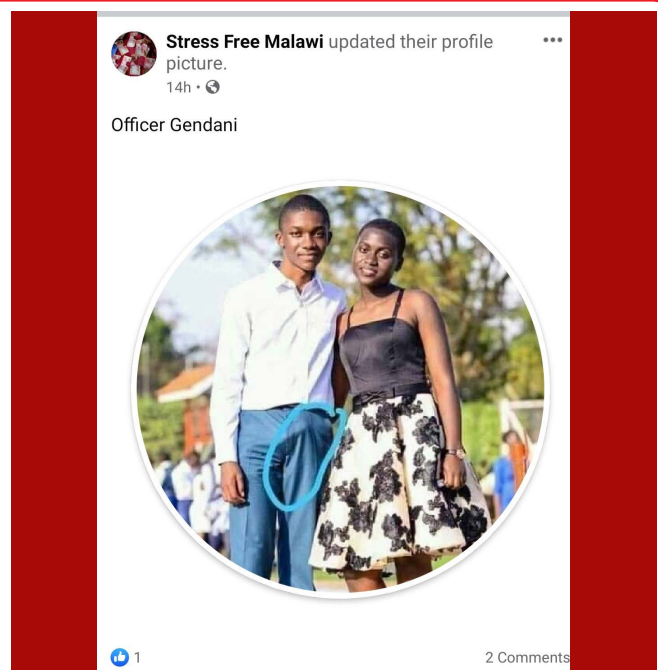
The muslims in Mangochi said they broke their fast following the Quran's 30-day-period-of-fasting mandate.
