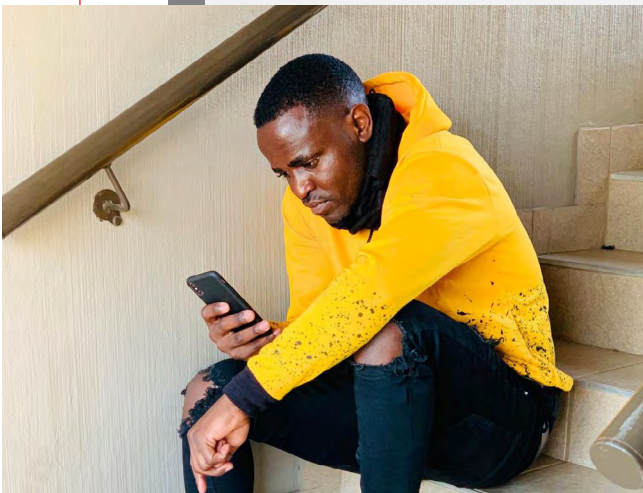

The team says the awards will take place on 29 May, online.

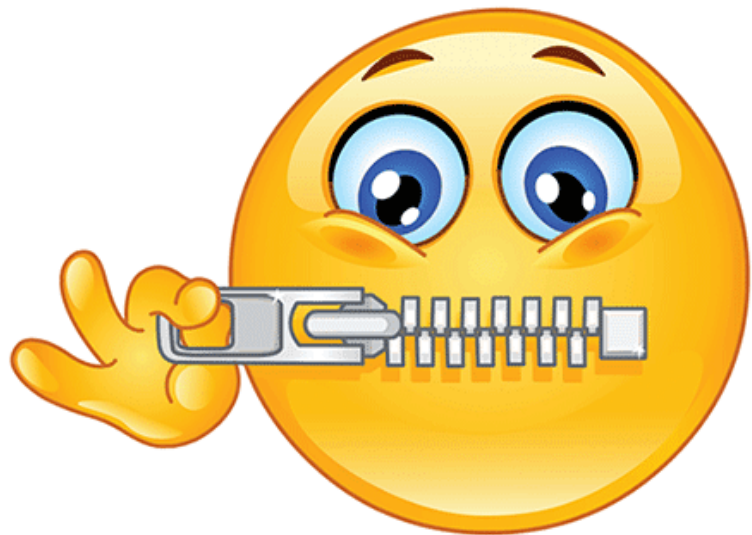
Phyzix has received 4 nominations, while Luki247, Martse, Vj Ice, Henwood, Tost, and Quest have also been nominated for the award show.

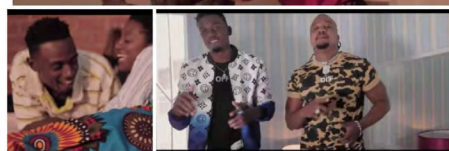

However, MCP wanted to be a part of the case this week, but the court has said, "Not today."

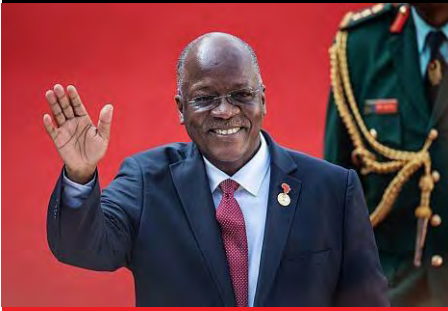
