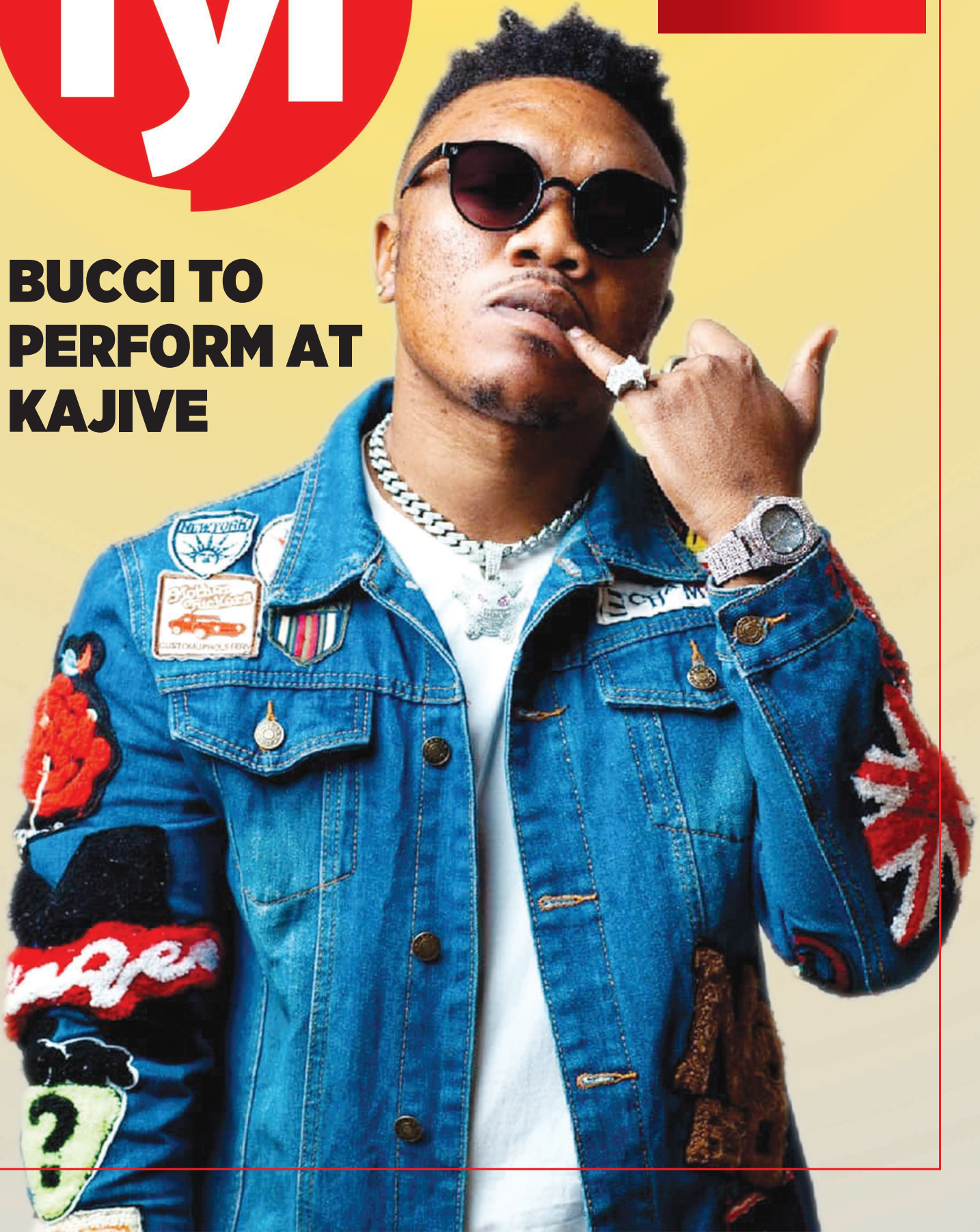

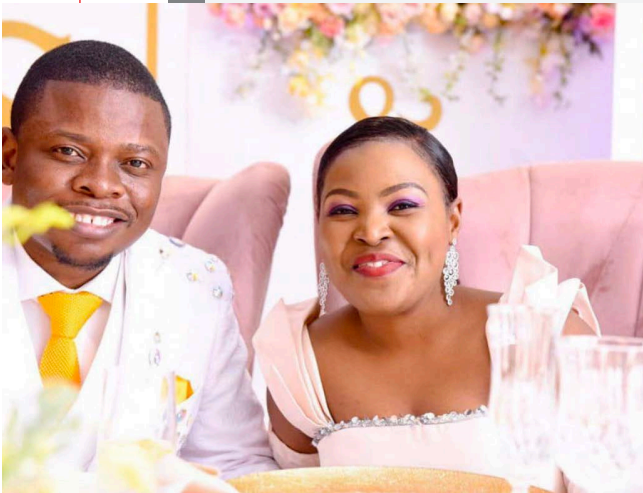

Bushiri Case Details

On 16 April, 2018, Bushiri addressed claims that were circulating around on the socials, as the Hawks had started their investigations, about him transporting R15 million to Malawi from SA on a private jet - he denied the allegations.

Well, the following year - on 1 February, he was arrested together with dear wifey, for fraud, money laundering and other crimes committed from 2015.

The heat was just getting started, as the couple appeared in court between 4 and 6 February, eventually being granted bail.

The case was then meant to start on 9 May 2019, but it was postponed.

The trial begun on 27 July 2020 - but it begun with commotion already, as the state wanted to push the case to a later date due to Covid concerns. But the Bushiris' legal team claimed

otherwise.

The court then granted a pretrial conference to be held on 16 October.

However, on 20 October 2020, Bushiri's wife was arrested for different allegations, making the self-proclaimed prophet turn himself in.

At this time, the couple were accused of fraud and money laundering of up to R102 million (about 5 Billion Malawi Kwacha) along with Willah Mudolo and Zetgu Mudolo (other suspects implicated in the same).

Well, while already dealing with these 2 cases, the question of whether Bushiri has a legal citizenship status pops up. At this time, SA's Home Affairs Minister has said that they had evidence that the couple went to South Africa on 9 September 2009, apparently using visitors' visas (and went on to conduct business with it, contrary to the permits of the visa).

Well, the Minister was spilling more juice on the day - as he said his Ministerial department had uncovered that Mary Bushiri once entered the country through the Airport with a passport in 2019 - producing a fraudulent permanent residence permit, which according to reports was issued on 1 February 1997.

But hey, the confusion? Mary had applied for permanent residence in 2016. According to the SA Minister anyway.

4 November 2020 sees Bonnie and Clyde (if we're allowed to take a leaf from social media references) get the bail their lawyers fought for. But little did the court know that 10 days later - Bushiri would be announcing that him and his wife had fled SA, as their lives were apparently under threat.

Malawi, citing the arrest that happened on 18 November by the Malawi Police was illegal.

Ndirande Kid Opens a Foundation

A 17 year old Malawian national football team and Gor Mahia football club player, Andrew Malisero has started a foundation which aim is to enhance the lives of athletes through empowering, guiding and counselling. Malisero said that the Numero Foundation will be working with all athletes from different sports disciplines. “We all know someone or some people that you know had the talents to make it big at their respective sports, but they lacked the guidance and the mentorship.” He said. The Numero foundation will be also in partnership with a mental health organization called Within and Without which will be helping athletes in strong mentality. As one of the reasons to start this project, he explained that he grew up in a place where he didn’t have people to admire since a lot of his fellow youth were fall into drug abuse and robbery. He also added that he almost gave up in his career after failed to make it in U-17 national team twice in 2015 and 2016. “The goal is to ensure athletes stay on the right track by offering them individuals that have already paved their way in their respective sports and turn their dreams into reality.” He said. ‘A boy from Ndirande’ signed a three year deal with Kenyan outfit Gor Mahia in October this year and became the first Malawian to play for the club.
