Unima insists on virtual graduation



The University of Malawi (Unima) insists it will continue with its plan to hold a virtual graduation for its first congregation of 2021 graduands, despite government's announcement to ease Covid-19 regulations.

Among the changes which were recently announced by Health Minister and Co-Chairperson of the presidential taskforce, Khumbize Kandodo Chiponda, outside public gatherings will now allow 250 people while inside public gatherings will allow 100 people.

Nonetheless, assistant registrar and spokesperson of Unima, Alfred Banda, said the planned easing of the Covid-19 protocols by government do not affect the nature of the scheduled Unima graduation on 28 April 2021.

"Kindly note that the preparations of the said virtual graduation are quite at an advanced stage now. Programmes were already printed and the Head of State and Chancellor of Unima, President Lazarus Chakwera was already briefed of the virtual graduation arrangements, he said.
