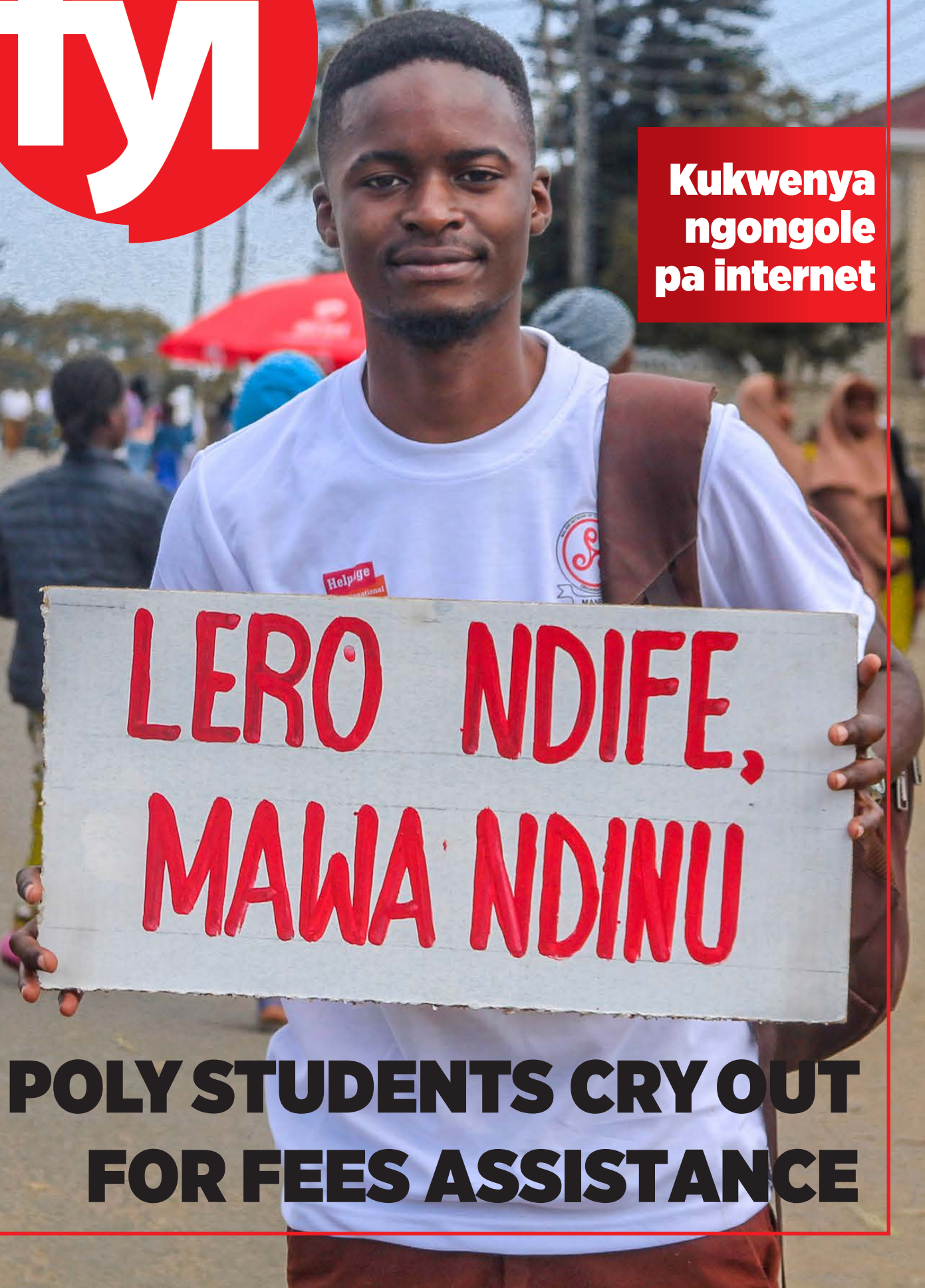

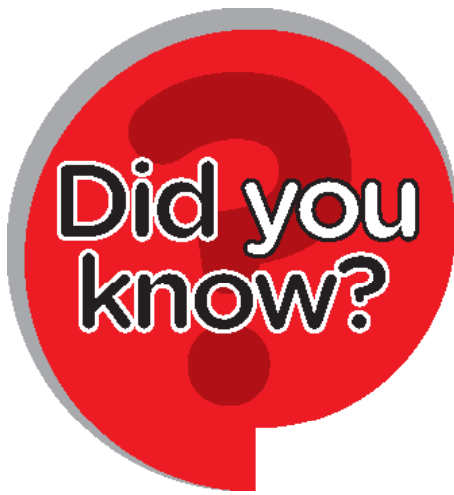

UNSUNG HEROS: Takondwa Lwazi

The 19 year old is a quick thinking, pacey left back. His professional career started out with the Premier Bet Wizards in the 2017-2018 season. He then joined Big Bullets Reserves after that season.

Charles played for the reserve side for a single season, during which he showed his confidence on and off the ball.

Multiple solid displays during the 2018-2019 season led to Charles Petro's promotion to the Big Bullets first team where he became a pivotal part of the 2019-2020 Super League winning team.

It wasn't surprising then that after his amazing performances in that season, scouts from abroad began to enquire from Big Bullets about

the availability of Charles Petro.

One of the most exciting offers came from South African Premier Soccer League side, Polokwane City. City were offering Charles Petro the opportunity to go and play in SA.

However, Charles' team of agents advised him against the move and he turned down the opportunity to go and have a trial for the team.

This is a decision the youngster would soon be proud of though, as in 2020 Moldovan giants, FC Sheriff Tiraspol, made contact with Petro.

The reigning Moldovan first League champions and most successful Moldovan team ever, did not only offer

Charles the chance to play in overseas, they offered him the opportunity to play in Europe with the chance to contest in the UEFA Champions League.

It was an easy decision for Charles and in January 2020 he signed for Tiraspol, moved to Moldova and became the only player in the current Flames national team currently playing in Europe.

Since signing for Sheriff, Petro has been impressive in his first 14 games for the club. He has made 12 appearances in the Moldovan league and 2 in Champions league qualifiers.

He was also in the squad for Sheriff's Europa league qualifier however he was an unused substitute on the day.
