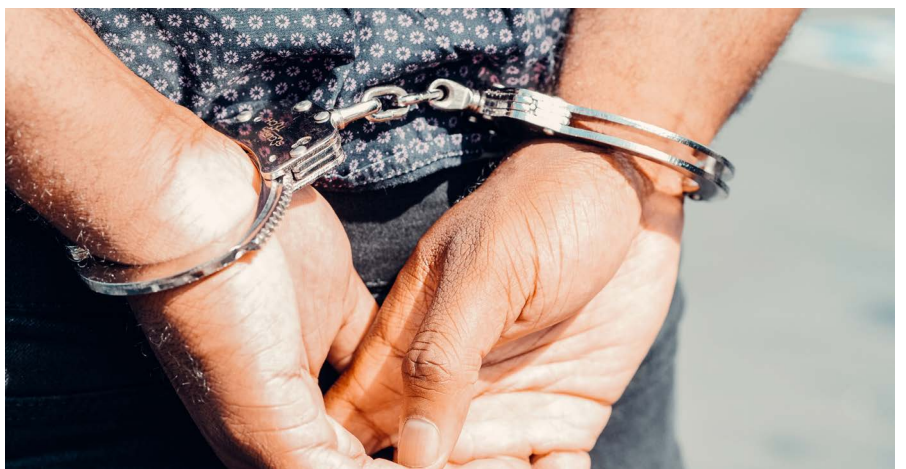
Nude scandal officer wins case

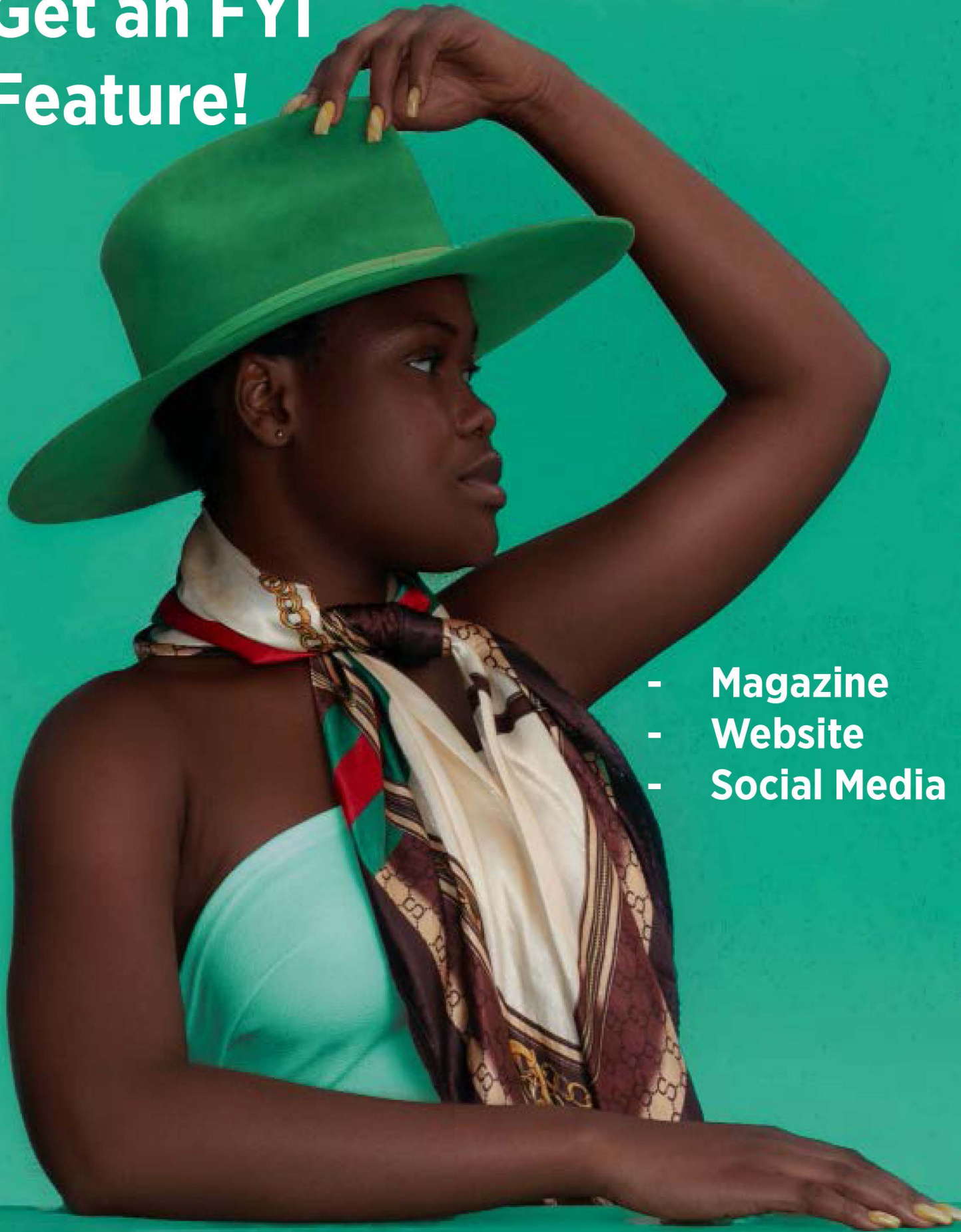

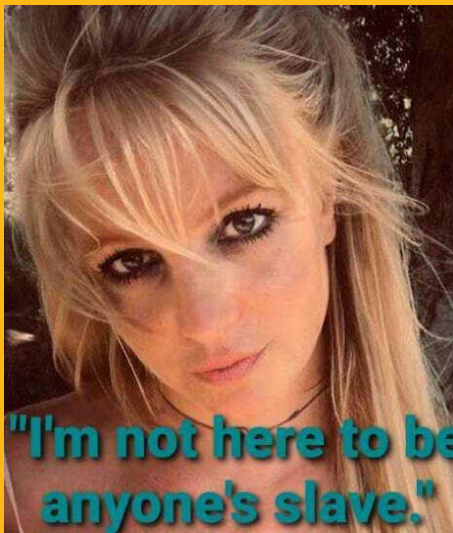
