The court case was made easy

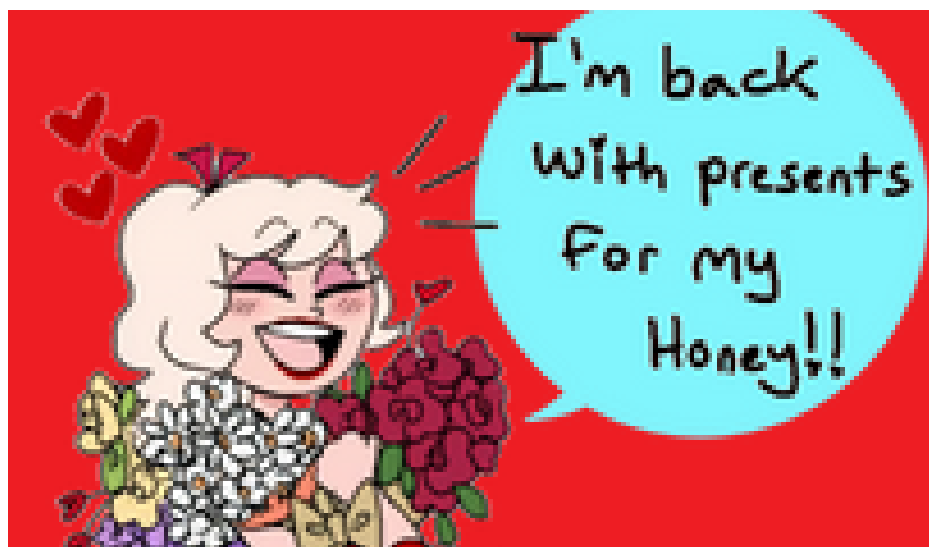

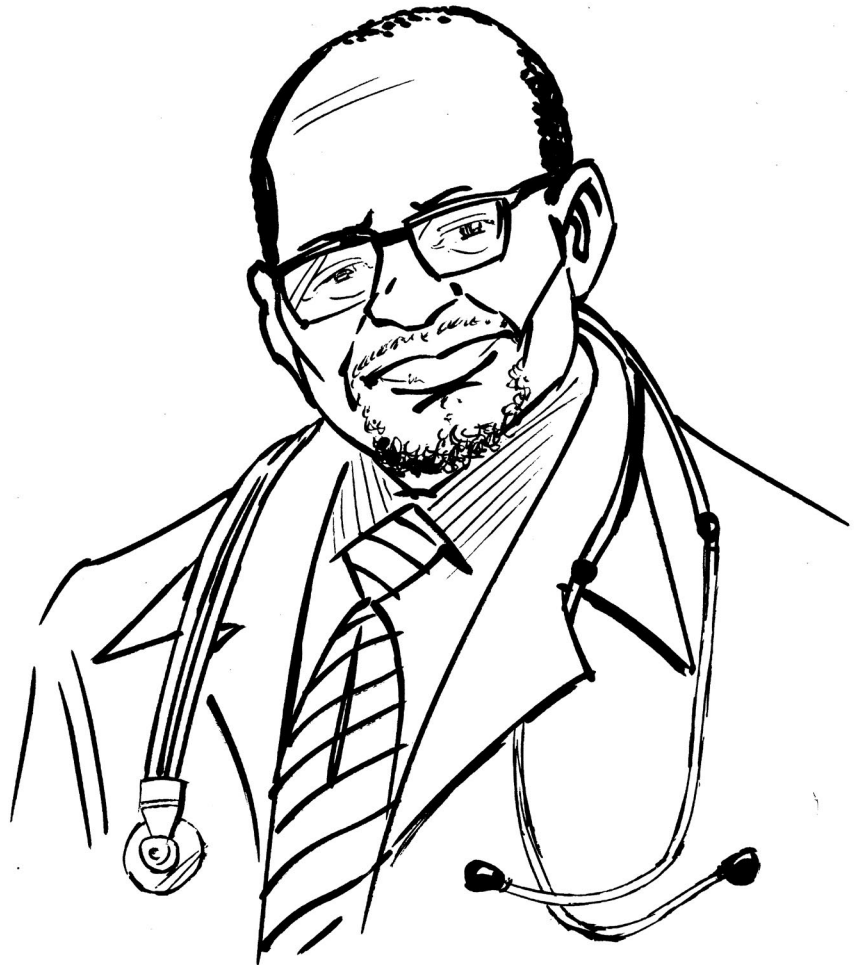

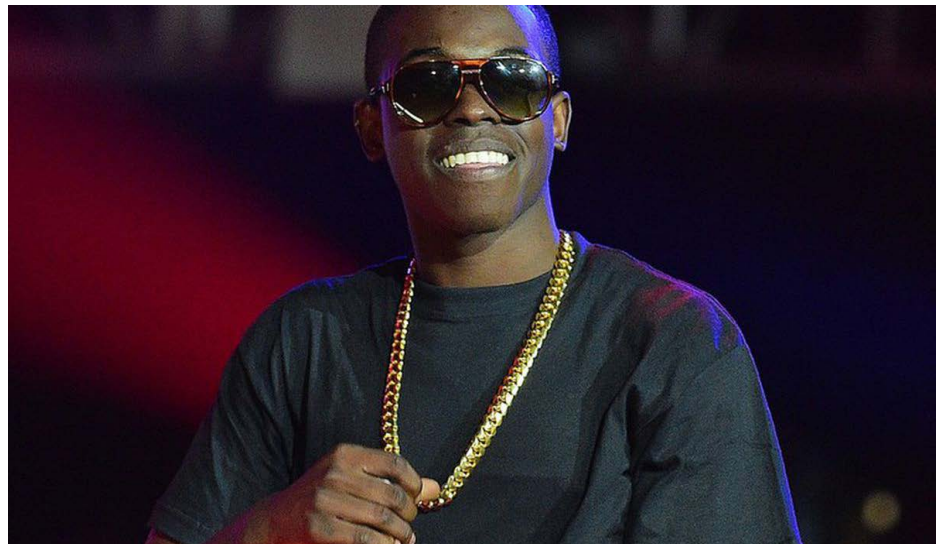
We hope you remember him – 'coz his hit single 'Hot Nigga' in 2014 was hot in Malawi.
