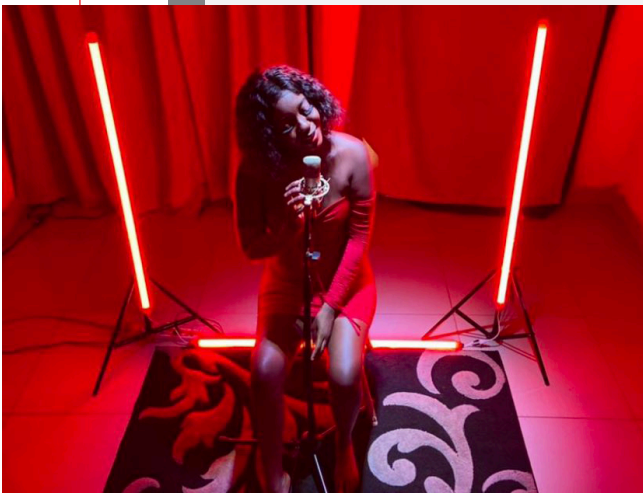

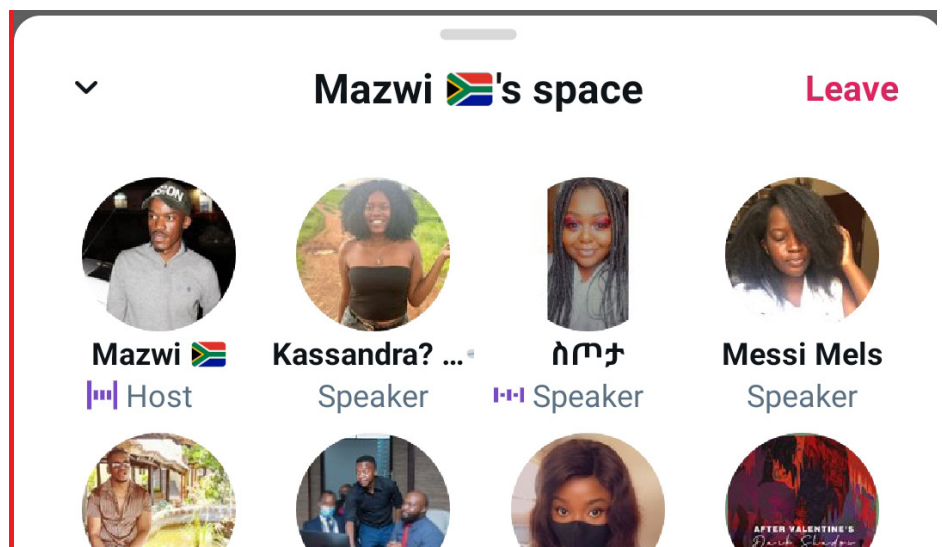
Twitter announced a new feature, 'Twitter Space,' in December last year, launched it in January but only for a few individual's test.

together. In simple terms, it's like a group voice chat.

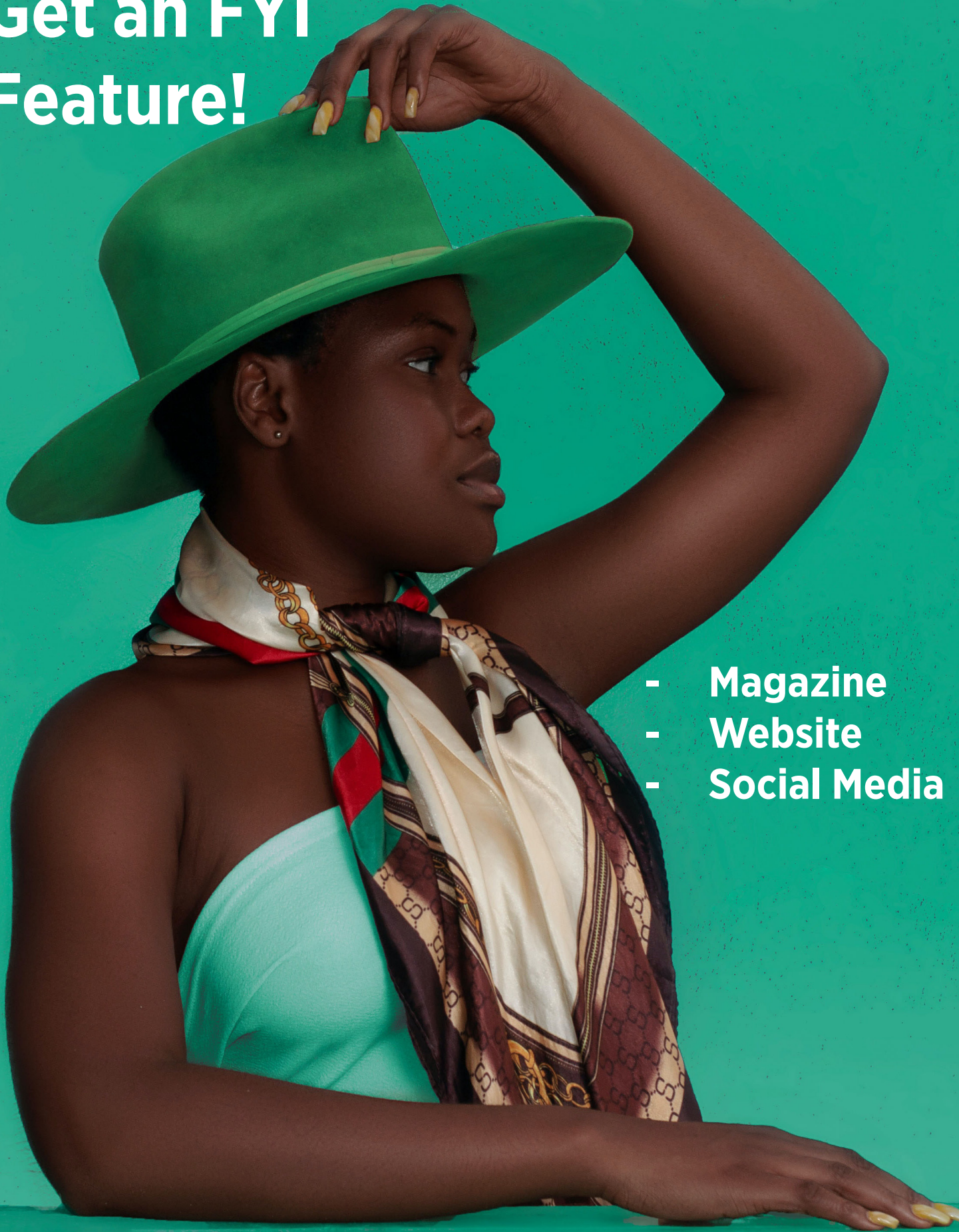
But, we've already seen some commotion taking place on Twitter Malawi Twitter Space. So, we've outlined our dos and don'ts on the Twitter Space:

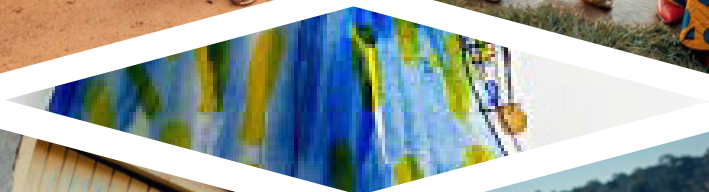

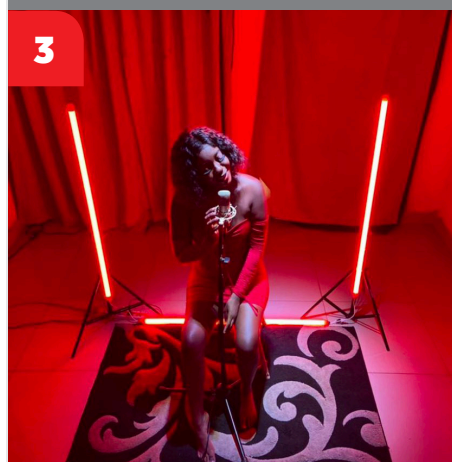

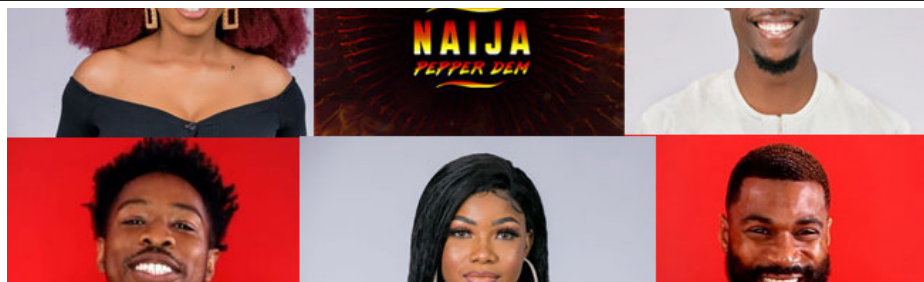
Kanye thinks Kim ain't serious

In her interview with CNN, Linda said she’s trying to change the world’s narrative of a “broke” Malawi.

“I believe it’s our duty and responsibility as creatives, especially in Malawi, where the narrative is usually only of poverty. There aren’t many people doing

this in Malawi. I think if other people can see someone who looks like them and is one of them (doing it), it makes them believe they can too,” she said.

Her designs (on page 5) are inspired by colours of the Earth.

Linda has however found customers in other countries – Kenya, USA, countries in Europe, and in Australia – due to Malawian’s lack of internet shopping capabilities.
