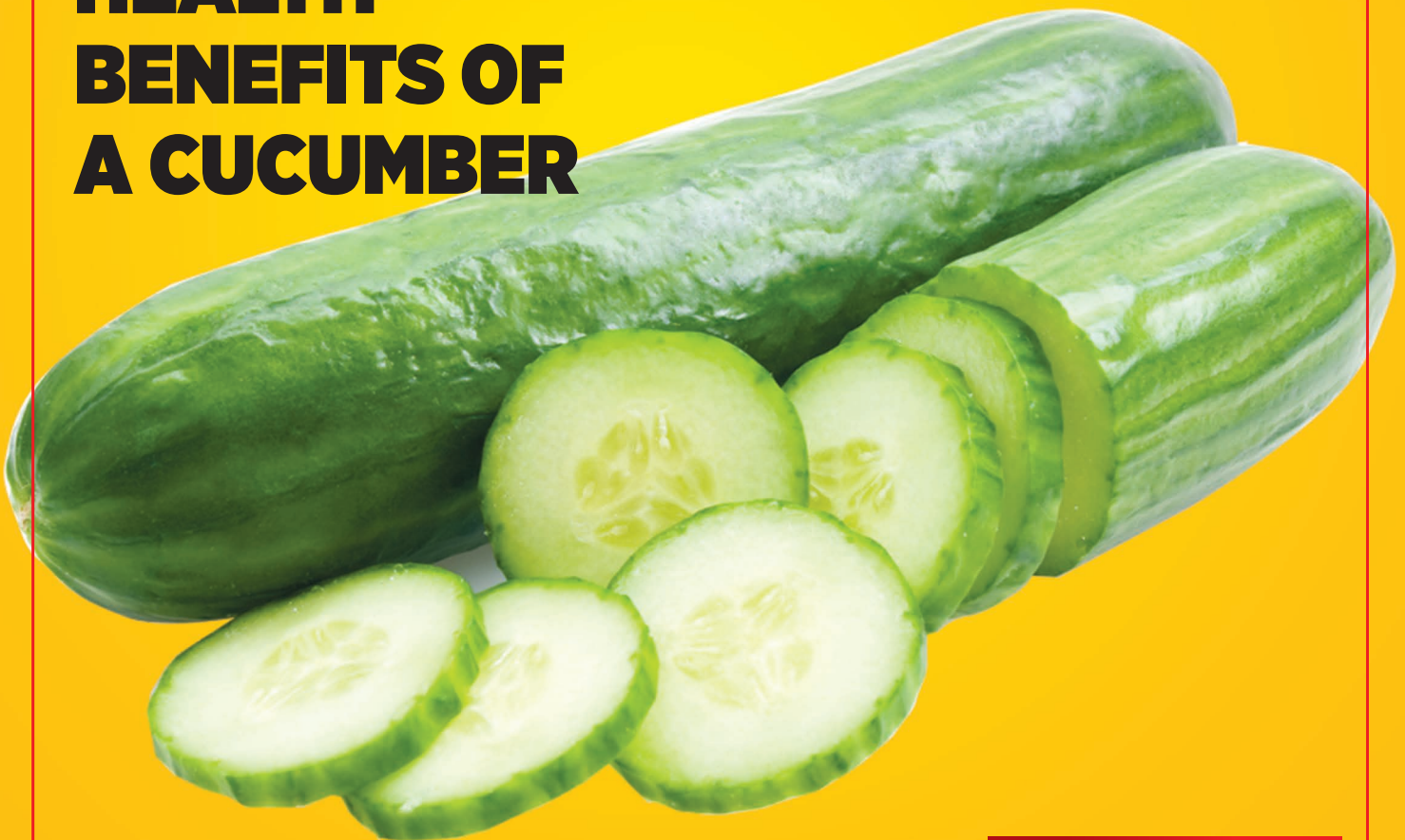

Transform community (T.O.C), a foundation established by a student from Malawi University of Science and Technology (MUST) yesterday has donated twenty thousand kwacha to Goliati primary school learners who were in need of examination fees.

The founder and acting chairperson of T.O.C, Matthew Banda said that they have decided to donate the fund to learners at Goliati primary school since the aim of the TOC is to empower education at all levels. "A lot of less privileged children have obstacles to access education fully. Many of

them they lack fees, school uniforms, writing materials and other resources, so as T.O.C our main aim is empowerment of education." said Matthew, who is pursuing a bachelor of Indigenous knowledge system.

Banda added that this is their first initiative they have made since the T.O.C established, and they are looking forward to do more as time goes.

Banda said the foundation sourced the funds from membership and monthly fee from its members, therefore he requested sponsorship from different individuals and companies

so that their project can reach out to many students as possible.

"As T.O.C we would like to encourage well-wishers and companies in the country to help us to achieve our main objective, you can see that we have managed to help 31 learners but there are many students who are need assistance. So with their sponsorship, will help us to reach many across the country."

T.O.C foundation was established on 15 October this year and has nineteen members.
