Kell Kay: UMP's 2020 system is TRASH

Three things certain in life: death, tax, and Malawians giving mixed reactions to everything and anything.

This week was nothing short of that – as the announcement of the Urban Music People (UMP) nominations sparked mixed reactions.

On one foot is an artist called 6th who, to most, doesn't deserve most of his nominations (with most particularly citing his artist of the year nod).

Well, on the other side, is one of the most well-known artists in the country Kell Kay, who didn't do much to get nominated this year, according to the UMP organizers anyway – tough... coming up with an award show is definitely tough bwana.

Well, in an interview with FYI, the award-winning artist

(regardless), expressed his distaste to this year's system used to nominate artists for the UMP Awards.

Kell Kay said the awards are meant to recognize and celebrate hard work but the reality doesn't reflect that.

“We all look up to UMP Awards; we respect that they're a big brand and I've always loved their work. But other artists and I have worked so hard this year, but our names are nowhere to be seen on the nominations list. Award nominations are not supposed to be based on sympathy or connections, but rather the work an artist puts in. I think missing out on artists like Macelba, Toast, Charisma, and myself shows that the system they have used this year is trash,” said the Nakupenda hit-maker as he added that

this will not demotivate him.

“We will grow bigger than their recognition,” concluded the artist.

Kell Kay has since shared with FYI that he is releasing an album in 2021. But before the year ends, the artist is hosting South African artist Mlindo the Vocalist in Lilongwe at BICC and in Blantyre at Comesa Hall on 26 and 27 December respectively.

“It has always been my dream to bring an international artist to Malawi. I'm a huge fan of Mlindo so when Gwamba made a song with him, I thought it wise that he (Mlindo) should come to Malawi. I talked to Gwamba, who talked to Mlindo, and that's how we got to know each other,” he said.

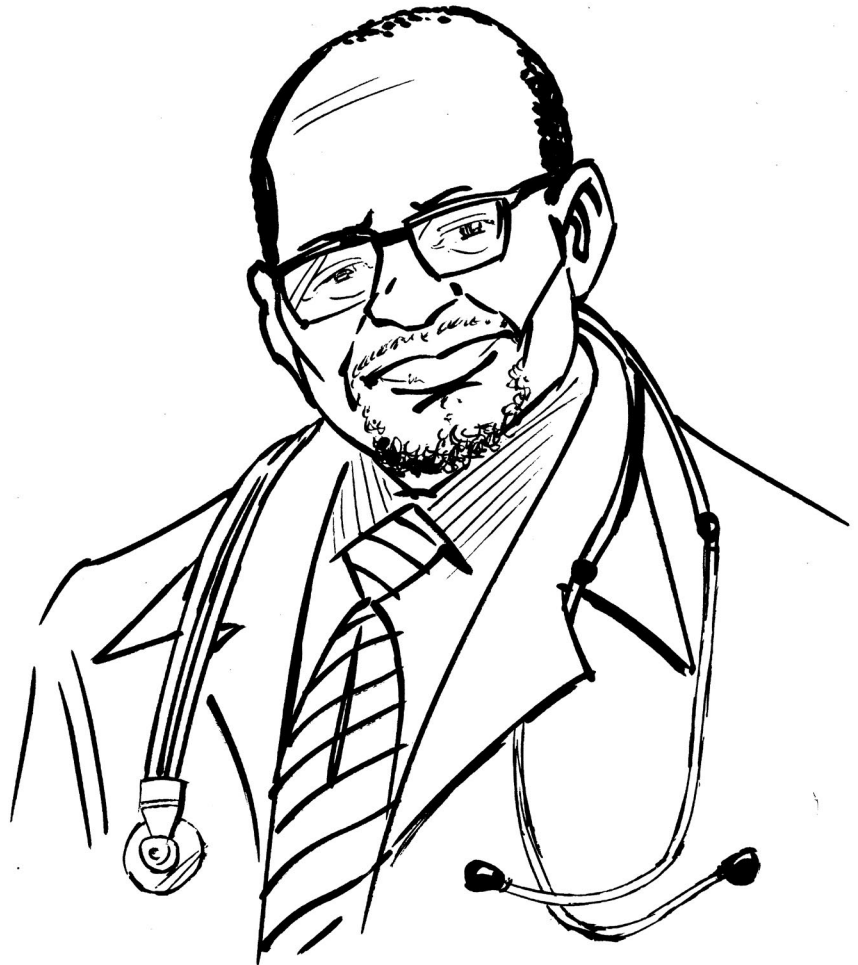
WEEKLY NEWS RECAP
