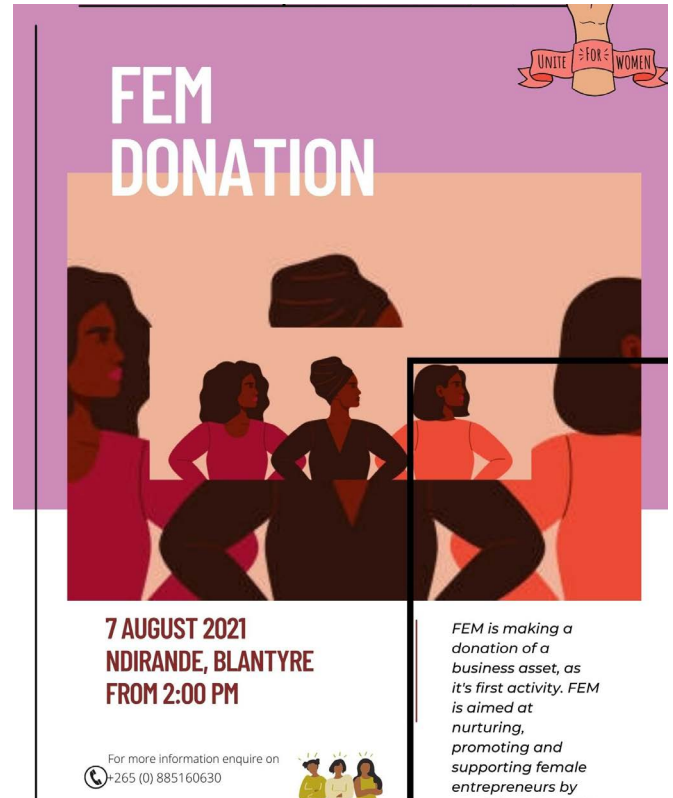

According to the founder of FEM, Ruth Bwanali, the donation is in line with one of the organization's objective - promoting female entrepreneurs that do not have the capacity to enhance their business.

In that regard, the organization will be making a donation to Josephine Mussa who runs 'Chikondi Disabilities & Orphan Care' in Ndirande, taking

care of a number of orphans and children with disabilities.

Ruth told FYI that the organization will donate 50,000 kwacha for chicks and chicken feed respectively that is expected to help boost her chicken business.

"We are providing her with these tools for her to manage her business and elevate" said Bwanali.

FEM has been established to nurture, promote as well as support less privileged females by providing them with business tools.

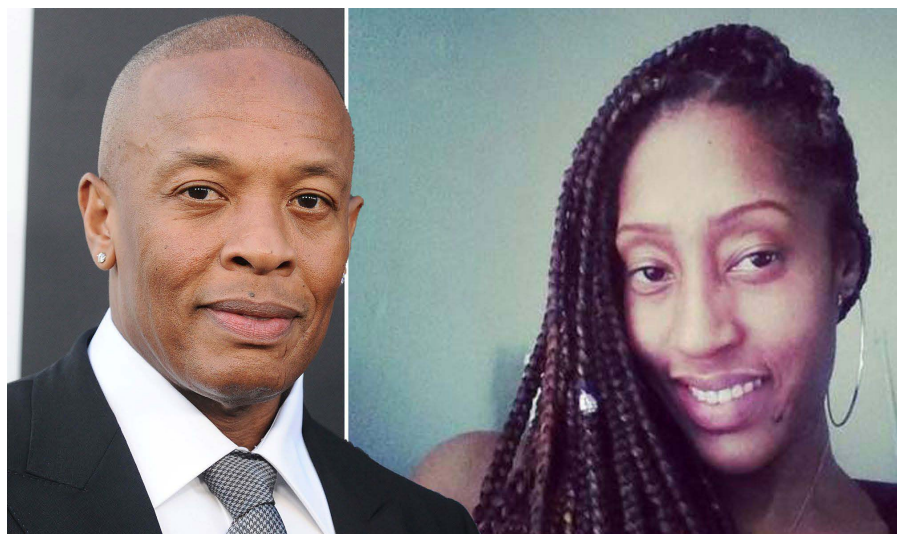
